Opportunities for Engagement

- Steering Group on Promotion and Prevention – *continued funding for ADVANTAGE best actions*
 - Provide recommendations to ESF+ programme committee and health working group
 - Make use of European Structural Support Services (25 billion) to reform long term care – *MS applications every October*

Funding

Regional Development and Cohesion Policy

- Policy Objective 4: A More Social Europe delivering on the European Pillar of Social Rights

European Social Fund Plus (101.2 billion)

- ESF +, including EU Health Programme and at least 25% will be allocated to fostering social inclusion

InvestEU – 4th policy window on social measures and inequality

HorizonEurope – taking forward SDGs and 5 mission areas

Digital health? – beware of digital divide and health literacy among frail people

Reduction in loneliness, Worcestershire, UK

Costs £330,000 each year to support up to 430 older people (c. £750-800 per participant)

Investors provided £650,000 in up-front capital - £565,000 as debt and £85,000 as equity.

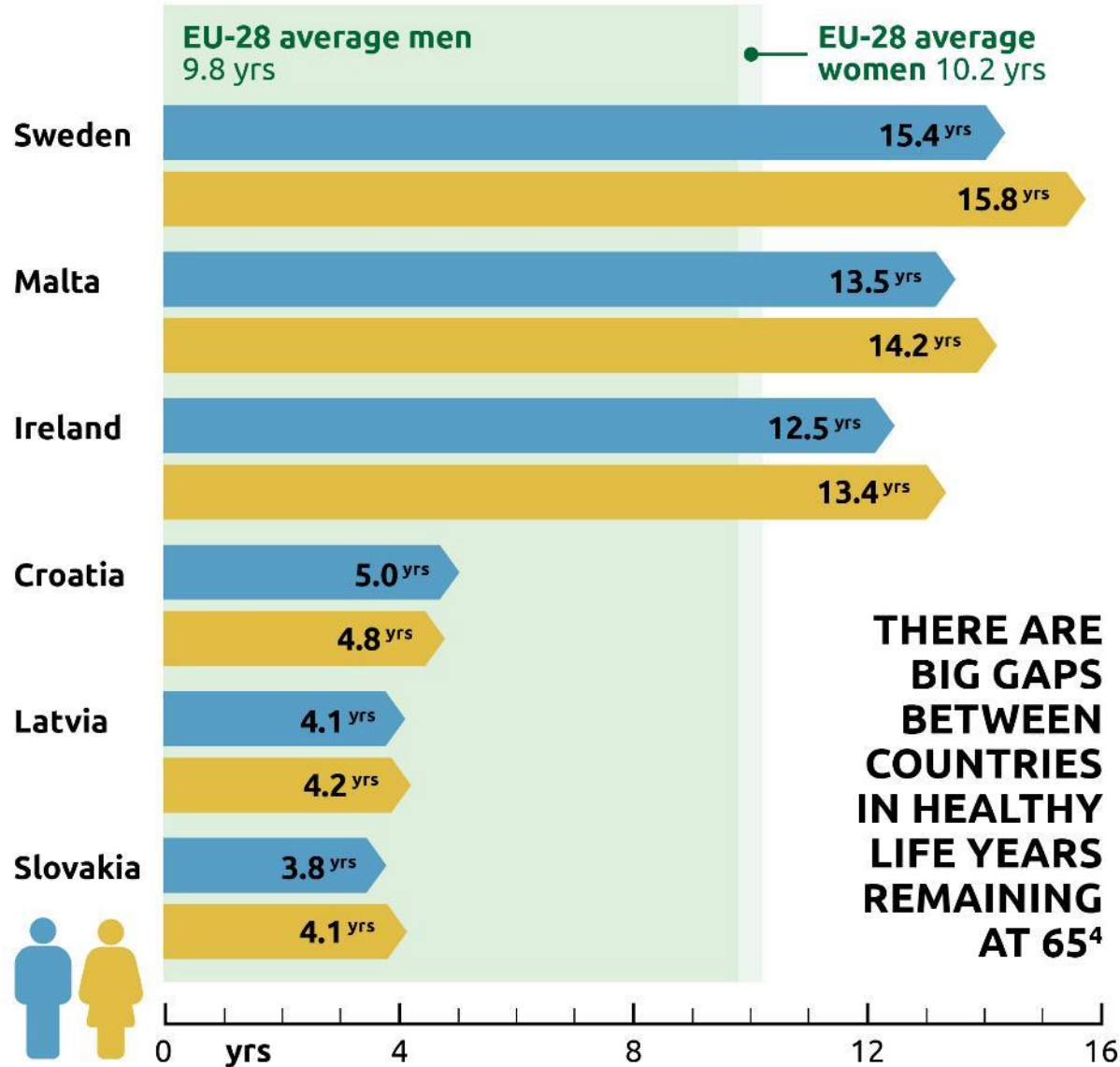
The first two years were loss making. As impact has grown the service is now able to pay returns

Expected to deliver more than £3 million worth of savings to the public sector over 15 years

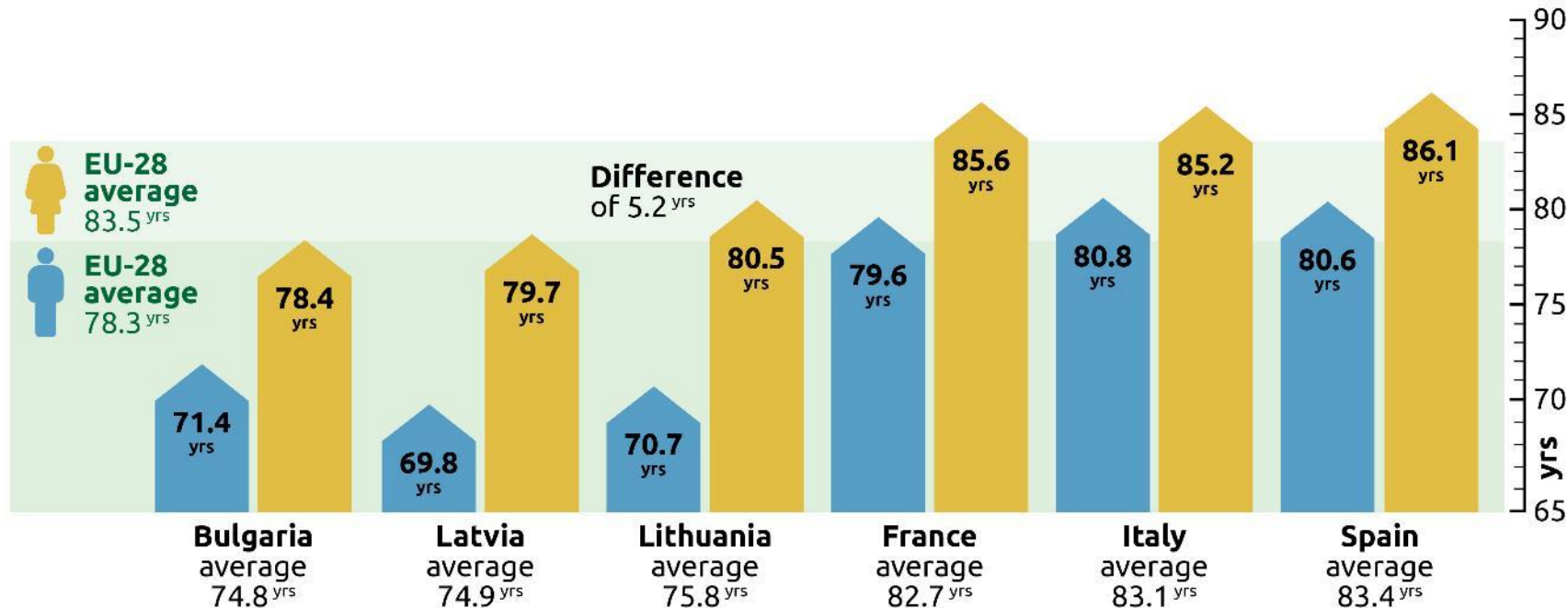
An equity perspective
